

# Corner Square Table Runner

## Materials:

$\frac{1}{3}$  yd - Center and Corner Stones (Main Fabric)

$\frac{1}{6}$  yd - Inner border

$\frac{5}{8}$  yd - Outer border and binding

Backing and Batting - 21" x 47"

## Cutting:

Main Fabric :- cut a piece 12 x 36

- cut (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Inner Border ( $\frac{1}{6}$  yd) - cut (3)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips

- subcut:

(2) 36" pieces

(2) 12" pieces

Outer Border and Binding:

- cut into (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips

Subcut:

(2) 36" pieces

(2) 12" pieces

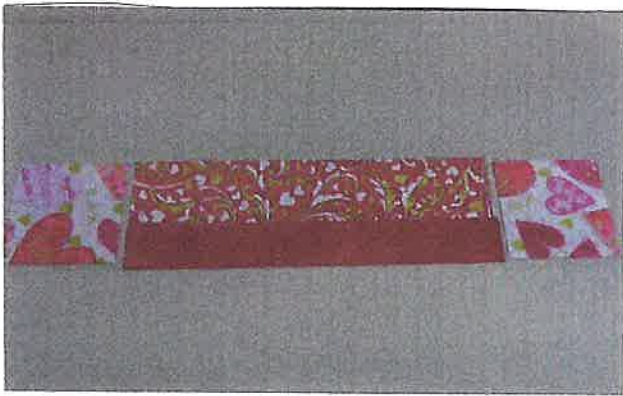
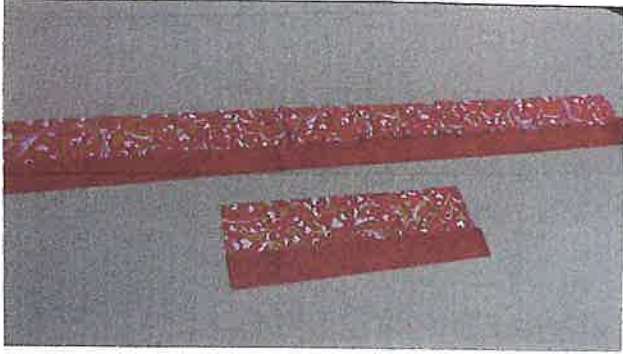
(4) for binding

## Putting It Together:

Sew the (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Inner Border and (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Outer Border together (right sides together).

Next sew the (2)  $12$ " Inner Border and (2)  $12$ " Outer Border.

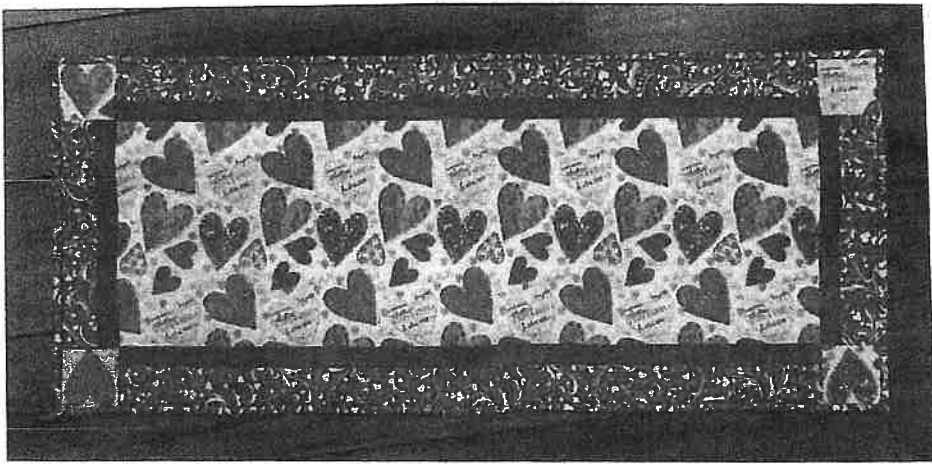
Now, sew the  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to both sides of the  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12" piece, as shown.



Next, sew the  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" piece to the center as shown.



You will now add the  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18" pieces to the sides (as shown)



Here is your  
table runner top.

You will now sandwich, quilt and bind  
your project
